## Shelter Programs

### Transitional Housing Program

*A two-year program for 18-24 year-olds focused on living in community. Youth pay a portion of their rent.*

### Common Ground

*A 30 day, 20 bed shelter for Transition Age Youth (18-24 y.o.)*

### Permanent Supportive Housing

*Scattered sites  
In partnership with Next Move, chronically homeless youth, ages 18-24, are given the most intensive supportive services.*

### Adolescent Shelter

*A 21 day, 6 bed shelter for youth ages 12-17.  
The only one in Sacramento*

### Rapid Re Housing

*Scattered sites  
A two-year program for 18-24 year-olds; youth pay a portion of their income to rent, living independently in their own apartments.*
